Ranking Sheet Information

1. Stream flow depletion will be determined using the 50 year depletion map produced by the Nebraska DNR. Depletion percentage will be determined by the well location.
2. Static water level areas will be determined using the long-term data that has been collected by the MNNRD and other agencies.
3. If the type of irrigation does not apply to an application (i.e. Livestock tanks or industrial use) the applicant will be awarded 10 points for this category.
4. No more than 2 wells per field will be allowed.
5. Compliance with NRD Rules and Regulations shall include all current Rules and Regulations as stated in the Middle Niobrara Groundwater Management Plan.
If no Middle Niobrara NRD regulations apply to the landowner then 0 points will be given.
