



# Protecting the

### **Cost Share for High Nitrate Wells**

- -Do you have a domestic or household well that has high nitrates (>10 PPM)?
- -Nebraska NRD's and NDEE are partnering to provide cost share assistance for the installation of reverse osmosis systems (RO's). This program will provide up to \$4,000 in reimbursement to qualified well owners.

#### Requirements for eligibility:

- -Register your well with NDNR
- -Cost estimate from licensed plumber
- -Water sample test results showing high nitrates, that is less than a year old.

Applications open January 1st, 2023. Call or stop into the MNNRD for an application and more details.

# **Water Quantity**

- -The MNNRD took applications for new irrigated acres for the first time since 2014. 2,999 new irrigated acres were approved by the Board in October. Directors and Staff will meet in the Spring to evaluate data and decide on the possibility of accepting new acre applications for 2023.
- -Staff completed 215 bi-yearly (Spring/Fall) well measurements looking at aquifer changes. Check out the MNNRD website or the link below for an interactive map showing aguifer data collected by the MNNRD.

### **Water Quality**

- -Water quality cost-share applications are being accepted until the end of 2022. Water use efficiency upgrades and water quality projects are eligible for up to \$2,500 in cost share
- -MNNRD staff collected 395 water samples this summer to be tested for nitrates. If your well is on the sample route, look for your letter with nitrate sample results soon.
- -MNNRD provides in house and outsourced water testing for domestic, livestock, and irrigation quality issues. Call or stop into the office for available services and sample bottles.

# Long Pine Creek Watershed (LPCW) FYRA & Cherry County WFPO's A, B, & E



The MNNRD and Houston Engineering Inc. (FYRA Engineering) are addressing threats to water quality and infrastructure within the Long Pine Creek Watershed. The watershed, approximately 332,000 acres primarily in Brown County, is mostly irrigated farming and rangeland around Ainsworth and Long Pine. Grants from NDEE & NET along with Federal funding through USDA-NRCS's Watershed Flood Preventions & Operations (WFPO) Program, are helping fund projects in the LPCW.

The MNNRD and E&A Consulting Group Inc. are in the middle of planning efforts through USDA-NRCS's WFPO Program on 3 Watersheds in Cherry County. Planning efforts will determine structural and non-structural projects through the Plan-EA's. WFPO Feasibility on Schlagel/Evergreen Creek Watershed has been completed.

### **Tree Program**

- In 2022, 31 windbreaks were installed with 13,304 trees and 52,778 ft of fabric weed barrier as well as 33,962 hand plants and 44,000 reforestation pines. MNNRD is taking tree orders for Spring 2023. The District has a listing of available tree species and can also make special orders. Some species have limited inventory. Cost share assistance, project design, weed barrier, drip irrigation, and planting services are available. Checkout our new website at www.mnnrd.org, call 402-376-3241, or stop into the office.

### **NE Soil and Water Conservation Program** (NSWCP)

- Sign-up for 2022-2023 has concluded. The MNNRD will be taking applications for 2023-2024 starting in May 2023.
- Trees 50% up to \$4,000.00
- Planned Grazing 60% up to \$5,000.00
- Miscellaneous practices include grassed waterway, pasture seeding, Critical area planting 60% up to \$5,000.00
